



## EQUINOX RANGE Femme fatale

### GRAPE VARIETAL

100% Gewurztraminer

### TERROIR

Single vineyard called "Felsack", which means "field of rocks". The vines are 26 years old and are worked according to the principles of organic and biodynamic farming (Biodyvin label). They draw their resources from soils composed of pink sandstone and silica scree, on a limestone bedrock.

### WINEMAKING

Manual harvest, with sorting of the grapes in the vineyard. The harvest is 50% destemmed, then gently and lengthily pressed. It macerates on skins for two weeks. Produced from wild yeasts, "Femme Fatale" sees no input during the entire vinification process, only low sulfites are added at the bottling. The grapes are self-sufficient due to their quality and the great care given by the winemaker in their handling. The "Femme Fatale" cuvée is made without clarification, and only with a light filtration, as everything is done naturally during the ageing process (100% stainless steel tank for 6 months).

### TASTING NOTES

The "Femme Fatale" cuvée is the EQUINOX edition of Fall 2020. "Femme Fatale" was born out of our desire to offer a white wine made like a red: an orange wine. The aromatic expression of the wine is richly nuanced: dried fig, rose, peony, orange peel, nutmeg... The palate is surprisingly vigorous for the grape varietal, a powerful sap lengthened by a mineral finish. Ample, straight and structured, it is an amazing Gewurztraminer. When talking about food pairing, this wine takes you on a journey: sweet & sour or spicy, it needs a cuisine with character.

### VIGNERON

This wine was created in partnership with Sébastien Mann, the rising generation from Alsace and already a great vigneron: "we want to share with you, through our work, digestible, healthy wines, as natural as possible and in perfect harmony with their terroirs". The 12-hectare family estate is located in Eguisheim, a village in the heart of the Alsatian vineyards, seven kilometers South from Colmar. Domaine Mann is certified ECOCERT and BIODYVIN, it covers a wide variety of soils, exposures and microclimates. Sébastien and his team take particular care in producing precise wines, thanks to which the word "minerality" can be fully understood.



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
